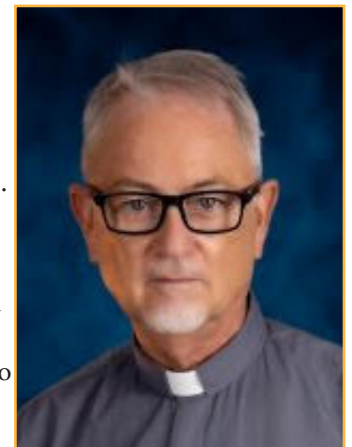
New Associate Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I am very happy to announce that the Jesuit Provincial Joseph O'Keefe has assigned and Cardinal Sean O'Malley has confirmed the appointment of Fr. Michael Linden as an Associate Pastor to St. Ignatius Parish. Fr. Michael joined the Society of Jesus in 1968 and was ordained a priest in 1980. He received a graduate degree in theology from the Jesuit School of Theology at Chicago and an MA in economics from the University of Chicago. Fr. Michael brings a rich background in pastoral activity and international ministry to our community. After serving a number of years in pastoral ministry in Kingston, Jamaica, in 2011, he was named the Jesuit Superior of Jordan and Iraq. He supervised the operation of English-speaking ministries in Amman, as well as the work of the Jesuit Refugee Service in Jordan. Most recently, he worked in Micronesia, where the East Coast Jesuits have worked for many years. We are very lucky to have such an accomplished Jesuit join our parish community. Please welcome Fr. Michael! He begins his ministry on St. Ignatius Day, July 31. We will celebrate his arrival at our Ignatius Day Celebration on Sunday, July 30.

Tenemos mucha suerte de que un Jesuita con tantos talentos se una a nuestra comunidad parroquial. Demos una cordial bienvenida al padre Michael que comienza su ministerio el 31 de julio, día de San Ignacio. Celebraremos su llegada el domingo 30 de julio en nuestra celebración de San Ignacio.

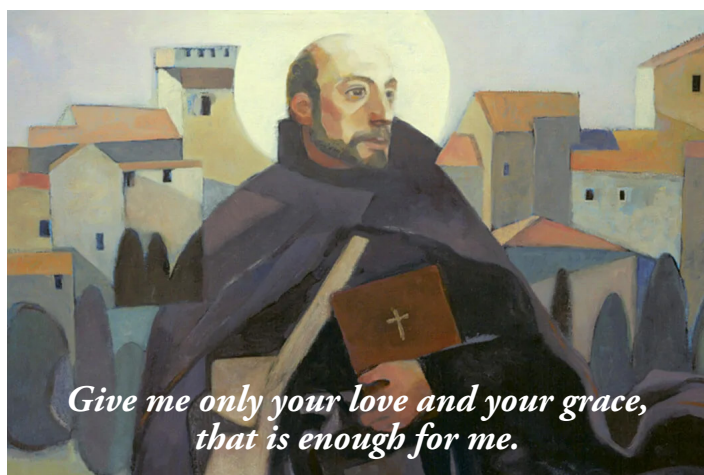

“**We Are One Body**” is a pastoral letter posted by the Archbishop of Philadelphia, Nelson Perez, on June 7, 2023. He also makes recommendations for the inclusion of messages relating to anti-racism in the liturgy.

J. Harold Berberick

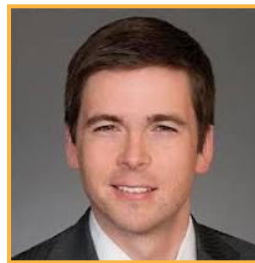

Order of Christian Initiation for Adults OCIA

If you are an adult believer and have never been baptized or were baptized in another Christian denomination, St. Ignatius Parish invites you to discern the decision to become a fully initiated Catholic. The process of the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) could be for you if:

- You've never been baptized and wish to explore a relationship with God through the Catholic faith.
- You're a baptized Christian who would like to share fully in Catholic communion through Eucharist and Confirmation.
- You're a Catholic who hasn't yet celebrated the sacraments of Eucharist and/ or Confirmation.

Come and see if this is the next best step in your spiritual journey! In the context of a supportive small-group learning community, we explore the richness of Catholicism and reflect on the meaning of faith in daily life. Beginning Tuesday, **September 19th**, the OCIA group meets on alternate Tuesdays, 7:00 -8:30 p.m. Sessions continue through Easter, culminating with the celebration of the sacraments at the Easter Vigil, and conclude in early May.
