Reflection on the Reading

Following the Easter season and the three great feasts of Pentecost, the Most Holy Trinity, and the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, we return to Ordinary Time and continue to follow the mission and ministry of Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew. In this Gospel passage, Matthew draws our attention to the mission Jesus gives the twelve apostles.

As we pray with the Gospel this weekend, consider how Jesus invites you to the same mission as these early followers. We are called to bring Jesus' compassion into the world, offering support, love, and liberation to those we meet. Today's Gospel reminds us that the kingdom of heaven comes through healing and new life. We received the love of Christ freely—let's share that gift freely with the world in return.

Carta del Párroco

Queridos amigos en el Señor:

Cada año, el segundo sábado de junio, los jesuitas en formación de Estados Unidos y Canadá son ordenados sacerdotes en varios lugares del país. Este fin de semana asistiré a nuestra asamblea provincial anual en la Universidad de Fordham, en Nueva York, donde serán ordenados cuatro jesuitas. ¡Me complace anunciar que uno de ellos, Jake Braithwaite, se incorporará al equipo de nuestra parroquia durante un año a partir de este mes de julio! Aquí tenéis su biografía oficial:

John J. “Jake” Braithwaite, SJ, nació y creció en Villanova, Pensilvania, y fue parroquiano de la parroquia agustina de Santo Tomás de Villanova. Estudió en St. Joseph’s Prep y en la Universidad de Fordham, donde obtuvo la licenciatura en Administración de Empresas. Tras un breve periodo en Wall Street, regresó a Fordham, donde trabajó en el departamento de desarrollo y se involucró en la parroquia de San Ignacio de Loyola en Manhattan. Las relaciones en la parroquia le ayudaron a descubrir su vocación y le animaron a seguir la vida jesuita. Jake ingresó en la Compañía de Jesús en 2015 en Syracuse, Nueva York. Sus dos años de noviciado incluyeron experiencias formativas en el Upstate University Hospital, L’Arche Syracuse, McQuaid Jesuit y durante los 30 días de Ejercicios Espirituales en Guelph, Ontario. Tras profesar sus votos en 2017, Jake comenzó un máster en filosofía social en la Universidad Loyola de Chicago. Durante su estancia allí, ejerció como capellán tanto en Arrupe College como en el Labre Homeless Ministry. Al terminar el máster, Jake fue destinado a la Brooklyn Jesuit Prep como profesor de matemáticas y capellán del campus, desempeñando un papel fundamental a la hora de garantizar que los alumnos tuvieran almuerzo durante la crisis. En 2023, se trasladó a Berkeley, California, para cursar un Máster en Divinidad, una Licenciatura en Teología Sagrada y un Máster en Teología Sagrada en la Facultad Jesuita de Teología de la Universidad de Santa Clara. Además de sus estudios, ejerció como diácono en el Centro de Rehabilitación de San Quentin. También pasó un semestre en el extranjero en el Hekima University College de Nair

Estoy seguro de que Jake será una bendición para nuestra parroquia y espero poder servirle de apoyo durante su primer año de sacerdocio. ¡Démos una cálida bienvenida a Jake cuando se mude a Chestnut Hill en julio! Letter from the Pastor

Dear Friends in the Lord,

Each year on the second Saturday in June, Jesuits from the United States and Canada are ordained to the priesthood at several locations around the country. I will be attending our annual province assembly this weekend at Fordham University in New York where four Jesuits will be ordained. I’m happy to announce that one of these men, Jake Braithwaite, will be joining our parish staff for a year beginning this July! Here is his official bio:

John J. “Jake” Braithwaite, SJ, was born and raised in Villanova, Pennsylvania, and attended the Augustinian parish St. Thomas of Villanova. He attended St. Joseph’s Prep and Fordham University, obtaining a bachelor’s degree in business administration. After a short stint on Wall Street, he returned to Fordham, working in development while getting involved at the Church of St. Ignatius Loyola in Manhattan. The relationships at the parish identified his budding vocation and pushed him to pursue Jesuit life. Jake entered the Society of Jesus in 2015 in Syracuse, New York. His two years of novitiate included formative experiences at Upstate University Hospital, L’Arche Syracuse, McQuaid Jesuit and during the 30-day Spiritual Exercises in Guelph, Ontario. After taking vows in 2017, Jake began a master’s degree in social philosophy at Loyola University Chicago. While there, he served as chaplain at Arrupe College and for the Labre Homeless Ministry. Upon completing the degree, Jake was sent to Brooklyn Jesuit Prep as a math teacher and campus minister, taking a central role in ensuring students had lunch during a bureaucratic crisis. In 2023, he moved to Berkeley, California, to complete a Master of Divinity, a Licentiate in Sacred Theology and a Master of Sacred Theology at the Jesuit School of Theology of Santa Clara University. In addition to studies, he served as a deacon at San Quentin Rehabilitation Center. He also spent a semester abroad at Hekima University College in Nairobi, Kenya, where he found immense support from the global brotherhood of the Society.

I’m sure that Jake will be a blessing for our parish and I look forward to being a source of support for him during his first year of priesthood. Let’s all give Jake a warm welcome when he moves to Chestnut Hill in July!
