The Racial Justice Committee highly recommends the new book *Subversive Habits: Black Catholic Nuns in the Long African American Freedom Struggle* by Shannen Dee Williams. Dr. Williams, Associate Professor of History at the University of Dayton, gave a presentation at St. Ignatius two weeks ago and discussed the little-known history of the racial segregation and prejudice directed at black Catholic nuns throughout the twentieth century. In addition to that sad history, her book also celebrates the contributions Black Catholic nuns have made to education, health care, and the Church.
