## From the Desk of the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

As of Saturday, June 10, 2023, the Vigil of Corpus Christi, all restrictions on the distribution of Holy Communion under both species will be lifted by the Archdiocese of Boston. As a result, St. Ignatius parish will return to the practice of offering the cup of consecrated wine to the congregation. I realize that not everybody is comfortable receiving from the cup, and it is certainly not required. Our Catholic faith teaches us that we receive the Lord completely when we receive simply the consecrated bread.

As we transition to a practice of offering both the body and the blood of Christ during Mass, our Communion rite, at least for the time being, will require the following changes:

1. Everyone will receive the host from four Eucharistic ministers at the front of the church (for now, there will be no Communion at the central break in the church).

2. As has been our practice previously, the cup will be available from ministers stationed near the side aisles. Please note that "intinction" (dipping the host into the consecrated wine) is not permitted. Should you choose not to receive from the cup, it is appropriate to acknowledge the Most Precious Blood with a gesture of reverence such as a slight bow.

3. Some parishioners may prefer to receive the host on the tongue. To keep the distribution of Communion as sanitary as possible, if you wish to receive on the tongue, we kindly ask that you come to the presider at the end of the Communion line so that those receiving on the tongue can receive together.

As we obtain a better sense over time of how many congregants wish to receive from the cup (and as we recruit additional Eucharistic ministers), we hope to be able to reinstate offering Communion in the aisle at the break.

Queridos feligreses,

A partir del sábado 10 de junio de 2023, Vigilia de Corpus Christi, todas las restricciones sobre la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión bajo las dos especies serán levantadas por la Arquidiócesis de Boston. Como resultado, la parroquia de San Ignacio volverá a la práctica de ofrecer el cáliz con vino consagrado a la congregación. Estamos conscientes de que no todos se sentirán cómodos recibiendo del cáliz, y ciertamente no es obligatorio. Nuestra fe católica nos enseña que recibimos al Señor completamente cuando recibimos simplemente el pan consagrado.

A medida que hacemos la transición a la práctica de ofrecer tanto el cuerpo como la sangre de Cristo durante la Misa, nuestro rito de Comunión, al menos por el momento, requerirá los siguientes cambios:

1. Todos recibirán la hostia de cuatro ministros eucarísticos al frente de la iglesia (por ahora, no habrá Comunión en la parte central de la iglesia).

2. Como ha sido nuestra práctica anteriormente, el cáliz estará disponible con ministros estacionados cerca de los pasillos laterales. Tengan en cuenta que la "intinción" (sumergir la hostia en el vino consagrado) no estará permitida. Si decide no recibir del cáliz, es apropiado reconocer la Preciosísima Sangre con un gesto de reverencia, inclinando la cabeza.

3. Algunos feligreses pueden preferir recibir la hostia en la lengua. Para mantener la distribución de la Comunión lo más higiénica posible, si desea recibirla en la lengua, le pedimos amablemente que venga al celebrante al final de la línea de la Comunión para que aquellos que la reciban en la lengua puedan recibirla juntos.

A medida que obtengamos una mejor idea con el tiempo de cuántos feligreses desean recibir del cáliz (y a medida que reclutemos ministros eucarísticos adicionales), esperamos poder restablecer la oferta de la Comunión en el pasillo en el descanso.

## Finance Council Update/ Actualización de Finanzas de la Parroquia

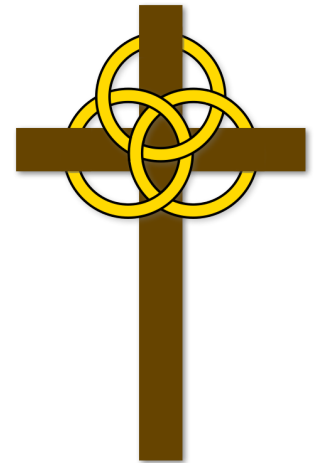
