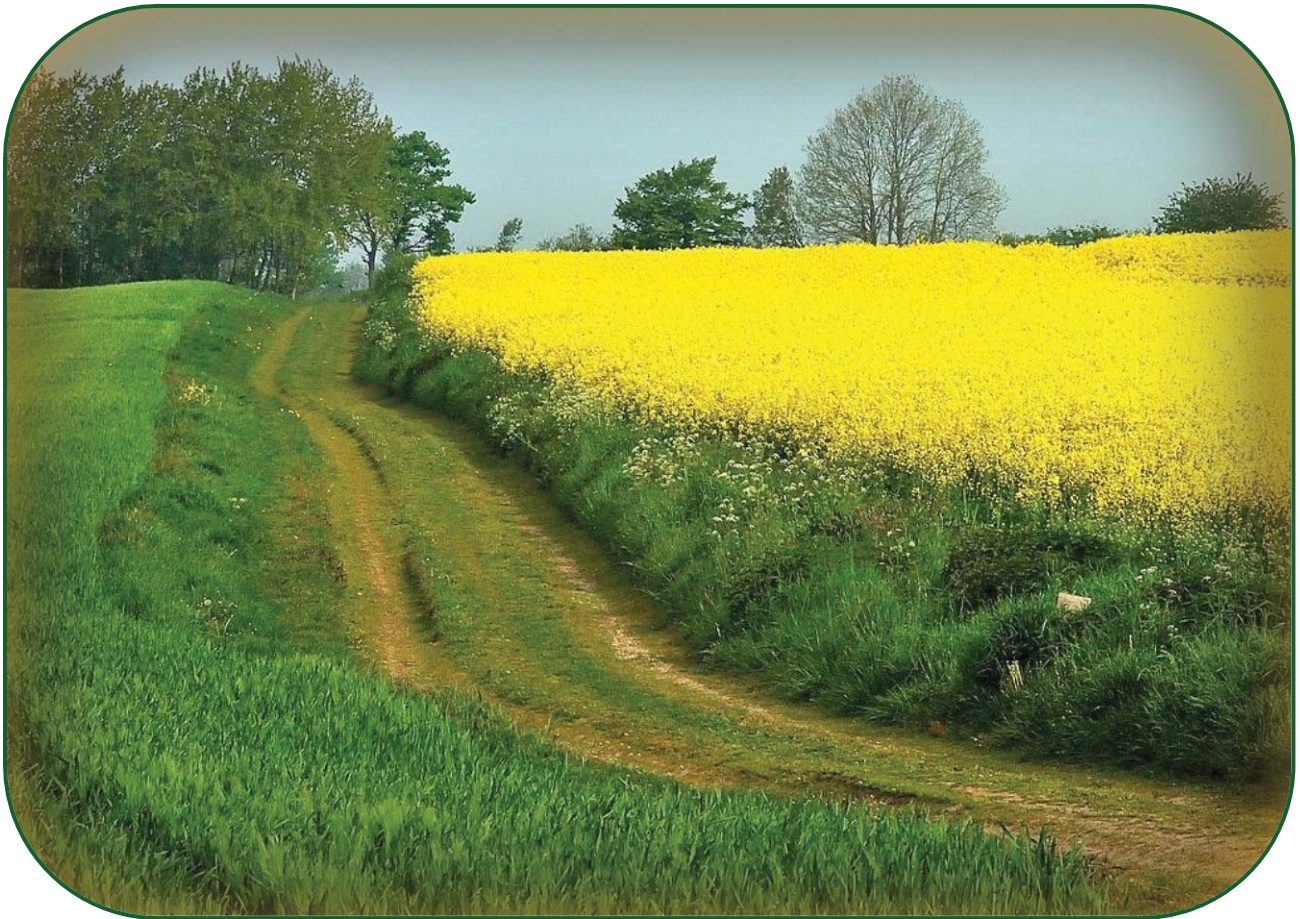

## Reflection on the Readings

Set in a moment of tension and conflict in John's Gospel, today's Gospel reading is Jesus' answer to the question, "Are you the Messiah?" Jesus responds by saying, in essence, "If you have to ask, then you are not one of my sheep."

We may be less familiar with the metaphors of sheep and shepherd than those to whom Jesus spoke. The image of Jesus as Good Shepherd and the community of followers as his sheep has endured over the centuries as a primary image in our faith tradition. Its power to describe the relationship between Jesus and his followers transcends direct experience with sheep. The image speaks to us about the protection, security, and care that shepherds represent for their sheep.

Today's Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice. Today's Gospel also speaks to the relationship between Jesus and the Father. In the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. To know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the life of God.

## Happy Mother's Day

Good and gentle God,  
as a mother you gather your children together.

We pray in gratitude for our own mothers, mother-figures, and all women who have joined with you in the wonder of bringing forth new life.

Grant all these women the courage they need to face the uncertain future that life with children always brings.

Give them the faithful support of family and friends as they care for the growth of their children and of others.

Give them joy in their families to sustain them through the trials of motherhood.

Most of all, give them the wisdom to turn to you for help when they need it most.

## Carta del Párroco

Queridos amigos en el Señor:

En la década de 1970, yo era un niño y asistía a una escuela católica polaca. Recuerdo que ahí el mes de mayo estaba dedicado a María, la Madre de Dios, y que también es nuestra Santísima Madre. Durante todo el mes, los estudiantes llevábamos algunas cintas azules y medallas en las corbatas, cantábamos canciones marianas en misa, rezábamos el rosario cada día y, dentro de los salones de clase, hacíamos pequeños altares con flores de primavera. Cada año se elegía a una de las chicas de octavo año para que coronara la estatua de María que estaba en el altar lateral de la iglesia, mientras todo el colegio cantaba “Hail Holy Queen Enthroned Above”, entre otros himnos marianos.

Hasta el día de hoy agradezco mucho a los profesores de mi colegio que, gracias a todas esas devociones de mayo, me inculcaron una amistad con María que me durará toda la vida. De hecho, siento que María ha sido una compañera constante y una ayuda infalible en mi vida, especialmente en momentos de tensión y angustia. A medida que fui creciendo, mi piedad mariana también fue madurando, especialmente cuando, más allá de ver a María en un pedestal, la comprendí como un ejemplo de discípula fiel de Jesús, aquella que siempre está del lado de los pobres y los humildes. Como dice Elizabeth Johnson en su libro sobre María, ella es “verdaderamente nuestra hermana”, amiga de Dios y profeta en la comunión de los santos. Es María de Nazaret, “una mujer pobre que canta su Magnificat sobre la caída de los tiranos y el saciamiento de los hambrientos”.

Durante este mes de mayo recordamos a nuestras madres y a todas aquellas que nos nutren y sostienen. Mayo es también el mes en el que muchos niños reciben la primera comunión. En la Eucaristía, Jesús nos dice: “Tomen y coman, esto es mi cuerpo entregado por ustedes”. El Señor hace esto al igual que una madre que amamanta a su hijo con su propio cuerpo y sangre y, también, con toda una vida de devoción. Me gusta pensar que Jesús aprendió mucho sobre cómo cuidar a los demás y luchar por la justicia de su santa madre, María. Rezo para que este mes de mayo nos acerque más a María y a Jesús, su hijo.

## Letter from the Pastor

Dear Friends in the Lord,

When I attended a Polish Catholic school as a boy growing up in the 1970s, the month of May was dedicated to honoring Mary, the Mother of God, who is our Blessed Mother too. For the whole month we wore blue ribbons and miraculous medals on our school ties, sang songs about Mary at Mass, prayed the rosary each day, and decorated small shrines in our classrooms with fresh spring flowers. One of the eighth grade girls was chosen each year to crown the statue of Mary at the side altar in the church while the whole school sang “Hail Holy Queen Enthroned Above” and other classic Marian hymns.

To this day I am grateful for the teachers at my school who introduced me to a lifelong friendship with Mary through all those traditional May devotions. Throughout my life, Mary has been a constant companion and an unfailing help in times of tension and distress. As I grew older, my Marian piety changed and evolved, especially as Mary came down from her pedestal and became an example of a steadfast disciple of Jesus who stands with the poor and lowly. As Elizabeth Johnson has said in her book about Mary, she is “truly our sister,” a friend of God and prophet in the communion of saints. She is Mary of Nazareth, “a poor woman singing her Magnificat about the downfall of tyrants and full bellies for the hungry.”

During this month of May we remember our mothers and all those who nurture and sustain us. May is also the month when many children receive their first holy communion. In the Eucharist, Jesus says, “Take and eat, this is my body given for you,” much like a mother who nurses her infant with her own body and blood and a lifetime of devotion. I like to think that Jesus learned a lot about nurturing others and fighting for justice from his holy mother, Mary. I pray that this month of May will bring you into a deeper friendship with Mary and Jesus her son.

Traffic and parking around the parish may be affected these weekends, so be sure to plan accordingly.



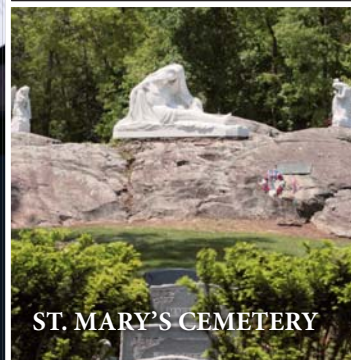
