Seeking Nominations for Parish Pastoral Council for 2023-2024

The Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is seeking to fill three slots for next year's council (September start). The Council shares in pastoral leadership with our Pastor by developing, shaping and implementing a Parish Strategic Plan in accordance with the principles of Ignatian Spirituality and the Mission of St. Ignatius Parish – "As a Jesuit parish community animated by the spirit of St. Ignatius, we welcome all to share in the joy of the Gospel and to come to "know, love and serve" God and one another."

We believe there are several reasons someone might consider serving on the PPC. First is the unique opportunity to share in prayerful, discerning leadership with the pastor to insure the mission of St. Ignatius. We all know of the challenges we face as a Catholic church in today's world. As a Jesuit parish animated by the spirit of St. Ignatius, we are blessed with Ignatius' spiritual foundation upon which to live the gospel to its fullest. It is both a humbling and blessed experience. Second, in working with the Finance Council and the various Parish Commissions, the PPC has the benefit of keeping abreast of and helping to coordinate the rich blend of activities and initiatives that enrich St. Ignatius' parishioners on our shared spiritual journey. Third is the blessing of being able to grow spiritually in a small group of dedicated council members who are committed to work collaboratively with the Pastor, attempting to bring genuine synodality to the parish.

We need members who possess an open mind and heart. Even if imperfect, as a Council we strive to discern the will of the Holy Spirit for our parish community.
