- Conversation with Carol Russo and Tony Compagnone, Liturgy Commission
 - The Liturgy Commission has 14 members, with each mass represented, and also includes members of St. Ignatius staff and a staff member from Boston College Campus Ministry
 - Commission is currently in the middle of Holy Week Planning
 - 12 - 15 people receiving sacraments at Easter Vigil mass this year
 - Feast of Oscar Romero Centennial Program planned for March 24th with witness speakers from El Salvador and Prayer Service for peace, migrants, and the wider Hispanic Community
 - Father John: The symbol of having the cup available is important so that we are all one community
- Updates from the Pastor
 - Father John shared a list of all activities ongoing in the parish in February 2026
 - General sense from the PPC that there are many activities happening in the parish and discussions on how we can get more parishioners involved
 - Father Matt is working to build up some volunteers to support him on home visits. Matt has taken on many of the home visits as an area of focus
 - Have we gone back to the wishlists of things that we can do from the potluck meeting with the staff?
- Status of Fundraising/Development initiatives
 - Conversations are ongoing with the Archdiocese of Boston on how to best support the repair efforts for St. Ignatius
 - General sense that a focus on music and homilies are bringing people in and keep people returning to the parish

- Fundraising efforts for immediate repairs are still ongoing by pastor
 - Scaffolding planned on coming down in the next 1 - 2 weeks given the warming weather
- Follow up discussion on ensuring the PPC is understanding and representing the spiritual needs of the parish
 - General discussion on ways that the PPC can better connect with the community and receive feedback from parishioners
- Status of PPC membership
 - The current PPC would like the group for next year to be broadly representative of the St. Ignatius community across all masses and backgrounds
