



## An Important Notice

Beginning on Sunday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, we will be reintroducing our 5:30 p.m. Mass. This will be in addition to our Saturday 4:00 p.m. public Mass and our Sunday livestreamed Masses.

Most protocols and procedures will still remain in place for our public Masses—like checking the COVID-19 health checklist before arriving and wearing a mask fully covering your nose and mouth during the Mass. Please take a moment to review our guidelines, for some of them have changed.

- Arrive on Time. We cannot admit anyone once the Mass begins.
- Use only the front, center entrance to the Church, being sure to keep proper distance on the sidewalk and on the steps. *[If you need special assistance for use of the handicapped entrances, please contact the parish office by Thursday.]*
- Wait for an Usher to take you to an open place. You may be asked to move into the center of the pew in order to allow other parishioners to attend.
- Once the allotted places in our Church have been filled, even if Mass has not yet begun, we will not be able to admit you. Please be understanding.
- Be sure to contact the Parish Office if you test positive for COVID-19.
- Regular check our website to see if we have received any notices of someone contracting the virus who was at one of our Masses.
- Keep a record of what Mass or Masses you attended with an approximation of where you sat for each of these Masses.

Certainly, our hope is that we may continue to proceed in this fashion as we consider slowly reintroducing other public Masses. We rely on your cooperation. Thank you.
